



Schools Team Racing Connaught Championship 2010

20th and 21st of March
Notice of Race

The Organising authority (OA) is Bow Waves Galway Sailing and Powerboat School in association Mayo Sailing Club. Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, Appendix D Team Racing Rules and the Prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association (ISA). The Regatta shall be sailed at Rosmoney pier in Clew Bay, Co. Mayo in Topaz Dinghies supplied by Bow Waves.

Registration will take place in Mayo Sailing Club at 0900hrs on Saturday the 20th of March with a briefing taking place at 0925hrs.

Eligibility: Entries will be open to teams representing schools in Connaught made up of members of the ISA or an ISA affiliated category 1 club which are currently enrolled in that school. The entry limit is 8 teams of 3 boats. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt with payment. If the limit is exceeded multiple entries will be reduced to 1 team.

Entry: A non-refundable entry fee of €150 per team. Entries will be accepted at Bow Waves until **March 19th at 1700hrs**. There is **No Late Entry Facility**.

Race Officials: One Volunteer from each school will be requested to aid the running of the event under Principal Race Officer and the OA.

Program of Racing: The Warning Signal for the first race is scheduled for 1015hrs. A round Robin Series followed by a Semi-Finals and a Final. The Format may be changed to obtain a fair result. In the event of inclement weather the event will be re-run in Galway on the 27th and 28th March.

Damage Deposit: Each team must deposit €300 by cheque or cash on entry. Deductions will be made in the event of damage. The Deposit will be returned on completion of the event with no damage occurring.

Schools with inexperienced sailors: The OA want to promote Schools Team Racing in Connaught and are running training days during March for interested teams. Buoyancy Aids can be provided to new schools if needed and need to request in advance.

Winners of the event will go forward to the National Championships to represent the Connaught Region in Galway City in April.
